CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- Before using for the first time, wash in a sink filled with hot soapy water and 120 ml (1/2 cup) white vinegar to remove manufacturing oils and polishing residues. Rinse thoroughly with clean hot water, and towel dry with a soft cloth.
- Clean after each use by washing in hot soapy water. To prevent spotting, rinse thoroughly, then dry with a soft cloth. Do not wash in an automatic dishwasher.
- Do not expose to temperatures over 400° F (200° C).
- Avoid prolonged exposure to harsh detergents, acidic foods, strong bleaches, and salt which may result in pitting or corrosion. Some foods may discolor the silicone head.
- To prevent scratches, avoid direct contact with other metal objects.

NOTE: Discoloration and pitting will not in any way affect the performance of the product, nor are they a defect in the materials or workmanship.

CAUTION: Never place in a microwave oven.

LIMITED WARRANTY

The Rena Ware Warranty

Rena Ware warrants its Spoonula to be free from defects in materials and workmanship for one year from the date of purchase. The Warranty does not cover defects resulting from misuse, abuse, negligence, accident, repairs or alteration outside a Rena Ware facility, or lack of maintenance. The Warranty does not cover incidental or consequential damages resulting from the use of this Product.

Remedy in the Event of Warranty Claim

At its option, Rena Ware will repair or replace a product or any part thereof, which is determined to be defective. If a replacement is made, the Product for which the replacement is made becomes the property of Rena Ware. This remedy shall be the exclusive remedy available.

To Obtain Warranty Service

To obtain warranty service, send a detailed written description of the claimed defect to the closest Rena Ware Service Center. You may be required to return the Product, at your expense, to the nearest Rena Ware Service Center in order to obtain warranty service. You may also be required to provide proof of purchase. If, after inspection, Rena Ware determines that a covered defect exists, Rena Ware will bear the cost of return delivery.

Other Warranty Limitations

This Warranty is in lieu of all other express warranties. Any implied warranty shall be equal in duration to the above express Warranty.

Some jurisdictions do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, or do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts, so the above limitations or exclusions may not apply to you. This Warranty gives you specific legal rights. You may also have other rights which vary from jurisdiction to jurisdiction.

This Warranty applies to the Spoonula only. Other warranties apply to cookware and other Rena Ware products.
